Description of the job profile	<p><i>Airline pilot needs to have good teamwork skills, good concentration and hand-to-eye coordination, be able to remain calm, and take charge in an emergency.</i></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- <i>To check fuel and weather conditions.</i></li> <li>- <i>To communicate with flight attendants and perform crosschecks.</i></li> <li>- <i>To handle flight emergencies.</i></li> <li>- <i>To operate controls and steer aircraft if pilot is incapacitated</i></li> <li>- <i>To fly aircraft for other reasons, such as charter flights, rescue operations, firefighting, aerial photography, and crop dusting.</i></li> <li>- <i>To perform pre-flight checklist on engines, hydraulics, and other systems.</i></li> <li>- <i>To take information from air traffic controllers.</i></li> <li>- <i>To ensure that all cargo has been loaded and that the aircraft weight is properly balanced.</i></li> </ul>
